

Guidelines for Runs / Walks In Tower Grove Park

Runs / Walks in Tower Grove Park are a pleasant experience benefiting participants, organizations, and the community. The Park welcomes such events at the same time we recognize the wear and tear caused to the Park by these events; please be considerate to the Park and have a great time.

To hold a run / walk in Tower Grove Park, you must adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Reserve a Start / Finish site. (See below)
2. Pay a participant fee. (See below)
3. Pay a refundable damage deposit. (See below)
4. Provide a certificate of liability insurance of at least \$1,000,000.00 naming Tower Grove Park and the City of St. Louis as Additional Co-insured.
5. Inform the Recreation Coordinator of any changes regarding the event.

Half Day Rental.....\$650

(Includes use of Pool Pavilion restrooms and electric, Concession Stand Picnic Site, and overnight storage in the concession stand)

Participant Fee.....\$200

Refundable Damage Deposit.....\$250

Park Provided Security.....\$30/hour per Security Guard

Other additional costs, if needed:

Commercial Vehicle Permit.....\$15

(Includes: portable restrooms, large BBQ grills, carnival

attractions, etc.)

Additional Security.....\$30/hour per Security Guard

Whitaker Stage*(25 piece stage).....\$30/piece or \$500 for full stage

*Park provides stage set-up and removal
